Colli di Luni is a DOC title for wines from the coastal hills around Massa and La Spezia in northwest Italy. It is only one of 15 of the 425+ Italian appellations that crosses over from one administrative region to the next. Everything about the Colli di Luni represents the transition between Liguria and Tuscany – the geography, the grape varietals, and the wine styles. The name refers to Luna ('the moon'), so given to this area by the Romans. There are connections with the moon on many levels here.

Ruby red colour with purple hues. The aroma is intense and complex, with spicy hints of black pepper and cinnamon. Hints of ripe red fruit are evident. Warm and persuasive on the palate, with great personality. Its great minerality ensures a pleasurable dry finale.
